**The 4 G's of
Discipleship
Process**

At FBC Kenedy we seek to **GLORIFY** God in worship, **GROW** together in small groups, **GIVE** of ourselves in service, and **GO** into our world to share the good news of Jesus Christ!

- ➔ First, **GLORIFY** God by attending weekly congregational worship services

Psalm 29:2, “Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness.”

Ephesians 1:3-6, “Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. 4 For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love 5 he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will— 6 to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.”

- ➔ Second, **GROW** in your relationship with God and others through participation in a weekly small group Bible study

Hebrews 10:24-25, “And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, 25 not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.”

Romans 8:29, “For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.”

- ➔ Third, **GIVE** of yourself in one of the weekly ministry opportunities

Mark 10:45, “For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

1 Peter 4:10, “Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms.”

- ➔ Fourth, **GO** into your world to share the good news of Jesus Christ in word and deed.

Matthew 28:18-20, “Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

John 20:21, “Again Jesus said, ‘Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.’”
